**Looking to apply for tax agent's registration? Improve your career options in taxation by gaining the skills and knowledge acquired in this course.**

This course provides competencies within taxation and law that may assist in meeting the TPB requirements when applying for tax agent's registration.

The TPB has set specific educational and experience requirements for registration of tax agents that must be met. TAFE NSW Northern Sydney has designed the TPB course in order to satisfy these requirements.

Applicants must apply for registration and gain advice from the TPB prior to enrolment as TAFE NSW Northern Sydney does not provide advice for this purpose.

## COURSE DELIVERY: ONLINE

This course is offered fully online (6 months) or by flexible delivery. Class attendance is not compulsory but students must sit supervised tests at Meadowbank. If outside 100km radius of Meadowbank, students must organise their own private independent supervision for tests. A dedicated online teacher manages the learning environment, communicates with students, supports student learning and provides feedback on work submitted.

- + prepare non-complex income tax returns for individuals in accordance with statutory requirements
- + encompasses gathering and verifying data
- + calculating taxable income and reviewing compliance.

### FNSACC601 Prepare and administer tax documentation for legal entities

- + identify taxation requirements for complex lodgments and returns
- + gather, analyse and process taxation related data to prepare tax documentation, and apply compliance requirements
- + taxation of companies, trusts, partnerships, superannuation funds and fringe benefits tax.

### FNSACC603 Implement tax plans and evaluate tax obligations

- + assess taxation liabilities
- + optimise tax positions
- + establish processes and plans
- + evaluate tax policies
- + review tax compliance.

### FNSACC604 Monitor corporate governance activities

- + research corporate governance reporting trends
- + examine corporate governance standards and practices
- + review compliance to develop and implement processes and procedures for meeting corporate governance obligations.
